The Health Services for the Homeless Health Center is a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) focused on serving at-risk and underserved populations in Springfield and the 3-counties of western Massachusetts---Hampden, Hampshire, and Franklin.

HSH is a collaboration of organizations dedicated to providing quality health care, dental care, behavioral health, and comprehensive support services to individuals and families experiencing homelessness who may be living in emergency shelters, transitional housing, domestic violence shelters, 'couch-surfing' with family or friends, living in cars or on the streets.

Additionally, Health Services for the Homeless also assists those having difficulty accessing healthcare and needed services due to lack housing, services not covered by health insurance, language barriers or difficulty communicating, have serious mental health and substance use disorders, and/or lack transportation.

The HSH Health Center provides services directly, contracts with providers for services, and has extensive executed referral agreements with community organizations, facilities, and providers to meet patient needs.
